

OSI Geospatial Inks Training Deal with US Navy

Ottawa-based OSI Geospatial will provide navigational software to the US Navy for simulation-based training as part of a \$925 000 deal announced Monday.

OSI produces technology that combines live data, sensor images, maps and charts for military, police and security applications.

In a statement, company CEO Ken Kirkpatrick said "Our US operations have developed significant capabilities in this area and this is evidence that we are getting some traction."
